ELDERS' PLANNING RETREAT

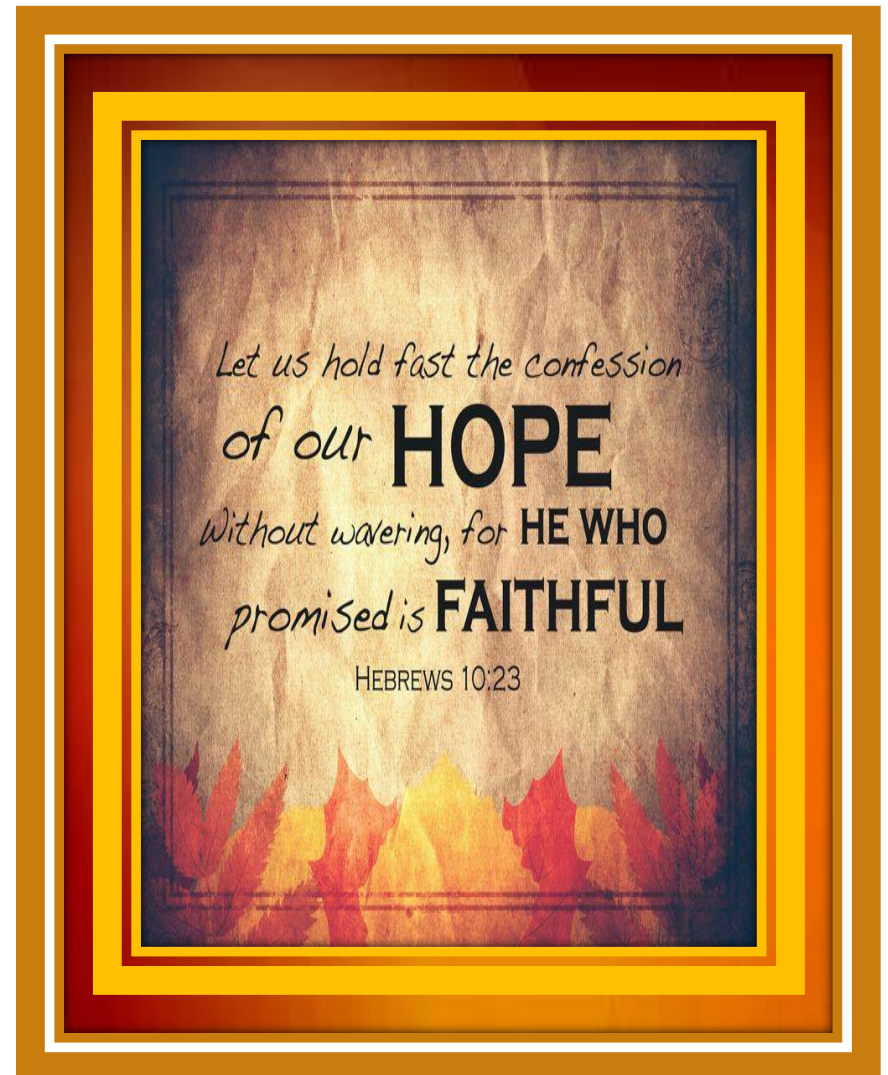
